

Dear Fellow Lifetime Learner,

My first book, *The World's Oldest Alphabet: Hebrew as the Language of the Proto-Consonantal Script*, went out of print in the first couple of months of 2020, which is the time when my publisher, Carta (Jerusalem), was just about to reprint the book. However, COVID hit Carta extremely hard, because most of their sales are to tourists to Israel who buy their books in Israeli and Palestinian shops. As a result, they have been unable to reprint the book.

Finally, Carta has agreed to reprint *The World's Oldest Alphabet*, but only if I can raise the funds to do so. At the same time, my new book, *Origins of the Hebrews: New Evidence for Israelites in Egypt from Joseph to the Exodus*, is about ready to print. After nine years of research and writing, it is in the final stages of my proofreading of the typesetting. My U.S. publisher for *Origins of the Hebrews* does not have the funds to publish a full print run, so I also need to raise the funds for this publication, so that 1000 copies of both books can be printed.

In light of this need, I launched a crowdfunding campaign on Indiegogo to cover the cost of the printings. The campaign page discusses the books and the campaign (which ends on September 14) more fully, as well as perks to those who donate. Please consider contributing to the publication of these extremely important books that present groundbreaking evidence of Israelites in Egypt from 1876–1446 BC, including the identification of Jacob, Joseph, Ephraim, Manasseh, and Manasseh's obscure son, Shekem, in Middle Egyptian (hieroglyphic) inscriptions, among lots of other evidence.
